A Guide to Manistee 4-H Livestock Council Sponsorship Funds

General Fund

The General Fund is the part of the budget that typically funds Fair Week expenses such as judges' costs, auctioneer costs, photography costs, scale certifications, pullorum testers and supplies, equipment purchases and maintenance, printing, and mailing costs, and more. Anything needed to provide youth a positive fair experience.

Education Fund *NEW*

The Education Fund is the part of the budget allocated to the costs associated with providing livestock education to participating 4-H youth. Livestock Education can include hosting clinics on topics ranging from Showmanship to Nutrition, General Care, Breeds and Breeding, Marketing Skills, Animal Science and more. Current species under the purview of the Council are Beef & Dairy Cattle, Swine, Sheep/Lambs, Meat & Dairy Goats, Poultry (chickens/turkeys/ducks/geese), and Rabbits & Cavies (Guinea pigs).

Technology Fund *NEW*

The Technology Fund is the part of the budget that helps keep the Council and program resources modern and accessible. New platforms such as Fair Entry and the Council's website help with tracking reach and growth of the livestock program. Fair Entry is used by 4-Hers to register for their 4-H fair classes, check-in day, results recording, class ordering and breaking, auction functions, and report generation. The Council's website has important dates, upcoming events, information/resources for each species for new and existing families, and more. The Technology Fund can also be used to purchase/update technological equipment and maintain it, such as laptops, printers, etc.

Buyer's Dinner Fund

In 2021, Manistee followed suit of several other 4-H Councils to provide dinner on-site to our 4-H youth, their families, and our buyers. We've gotten so much positive feedback on this; it's quickly become an annual addition to Auction night. Help us keep this catered meal a staple of the Manistee County Fair with a donation to this fund.
